



The Champions of Science Dinner is an occasion to celebrate both the success of local students in the North Museum Science and Engineering Fair and the support of the community for this effort.

Students who are champions or have won a first place award in their category are invited to display their project for all the guests (typically over 200 attendees). Students typically arrive by 4:30 PM, set up their display, and field questions from other guests before the dinner formally begins. These winners and the teachers who sponsor students in the NMSEF are all provided tickets to this event at no cost to themselves.

The program for the evening includes recognition of all these winners, remarks by the champion level students, presentation of an award to a notable local science educator, remarks by the Fair leadership team, and a brief talk by an invited guest scientist or notable advocate for science.

From involved teachers to community leaders, fair judges to excited parents and students, the Champions Dinner has evolved into a very special evening celebrating the pursuit of scientific knowledge in Lancaster County and beyond.
